- a. In the **Study Regions** page click **Define Study Regions...**
- b. For our Brevard County model
  - 1. Click the carrot icon to the left of **Counties**, **ZIP Codes and Congressional Districts**
  - 2. Click the carrot icon next to **FLORIDA**
  - 3. Click the box icon next to **Brevard County**
- c. Click **Show Selected** to confirm you have selected the correct region
